Since retirement from DuPont, Mr. Burt has applied insights gained as an active participant in ADR through affiliation with the International Institute for Conflict Prevention and Resolution (CPR). Past chair of CPR's Mediation and Executive Advisory Committees, he now is Executive Consultant to CPR. He is a member of the Steering Committee of the Corporate Counsel International Arbitration Group (CCIAG). He has served the Straus Institute for Dispute Resolution (Pepperdine University School of Law) on its Council of Distinguished Advisors, and as a contributing member of the International Task Force on Mixed Mode Dispute Resolution.
